Matt and Amy's Hope

After unexpected medical emergencies, Matt and Amy were drowning in bills when Cradle of Hope stepped in to help.



Matt and Amy have been married for three years and both work full time. They earn enough money to pay their bills and have a small amount left over. Once they found out they were pregnant, they set this extra money aside, as little as it was,

anticipating all the costs associated with the birth of their daughter and knowing that Amy would be without work, or an income, during her maternity leave. They were hopeful about the birth of their daughter as were their families.

However, four days after the birth of their baby, Amy had to return to the hospital for surgery due to complications from the pregnancy. Nine days after the birth of their baby, Matt had neck surgery and shortly after, he returned to the hospital due to a life-threatening staph infection. They were not prepared for these medical emergencies or how this would financially affect them.

Amy returned to work much sooner than expected and had been making partial payments but was falling further and further behind with paying bills. Additionally, over \$500 of each paycheck was being withheld to pay insurance costs that were not paid during her maternity leave. A public health nurse had been trying to help her, but several agencies already told her they didn't have any more funds available. Her landlord was willing to work out a payment plan and both their families helped out with some expenses.

She felt like she was drowning and that's when Cradle of Hope stepped in to help.

"We will forever be grateful for your kindness and support through the hardest time in our life. Your help with paying our rent and a surprise baby shower basket gave me hope in a time when everything else seemed to be failing me. When my daughter is old enough to understand, I will tell her about how you made it possible for us to be where we are today. Thank you!"

Portable Cribs:



Distribute 1,600 portable cribs so every baby has a safe place to sleep.

Rent/Mortgage:



Provide 425 families with rent/mortgage assistance so they can stay in their homes.

Child Care:



Provide five families with child care costs for up to one month so mom can return to her job following unpaid maternity leave.

Transportation:



Distribute 20 monthly transportation cards so moms can return to work after unpaid maternity leave.

Utilities:



Provide 50 families with utility assistance for one month.

Training:



Provide 390 individuals with infant safe sleep training which helps reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS).

Baby Shower Baskets:



Distribute 500 baskets filled with essential baby items to help mom and baby begin their life together.

Medical Costs:



Provide 10 families with assistance paying medical costs.

SAFE SLEEP TRAINING

Here's a list of reasons you should attend the Safe Sleep Training. We want our babies to always be safe, and that includes sleeping safely.

3,700 babies die each year

Each year, more than 3,700 babies die due to SUID, some of these deaths are preventable!



It can happen to anyone.

In Minnesota alone there are more than 50 babies that die each year due to SIDS or other sleep related causes of infant death.

Education!

You will learn the best practices for keeping your baby as safe as possible while sleeping including action steps like the ABC's of Safe Sleep.

FREE CRIB

Upon completion of the training, you will receive a free, safety-approved portable crib for your baby.

FREE Baby Shower Basket

You will also receive a baby shower basket that is filled with new baby items like diapers, wipes, clothing, bottles, and more!
